Dear Parents/Carers

I hope this letter finds you well.

As our latest round of after academy clubs have finished, it is a good time to review the enrichments that the academy provides for the children at Croxby.

For the fifth consecutive term the academy has had around 20 after academy clubs with approximately 60% of children attending at least one club.

So far this year, 7 classes have worked with NAPA our musical theatre provider, with 3 more classes starting this week. It is always a pleasure to see all of the children appear on the stage. We are looking to expand this provision further in September.

We have just initiated discussions with the East Riding Council, to extend our music offerings to the whole of Key Stage 2, learning two musical instruments next year. This is a big ambition but one we are confident in achieving from September.

Auditions for 'Oliver' have recently taken place with a large amount of children taking part. Although it is a difficult job for Miss Rehman, all children who auditioned have a part in the production.

For the first time in many years, it was great to see netball being played at Croxby. Willerby provided a stern competition for our girls but they represented the academy with distinction. The girls' football team showed a great promise in their tournament with Mr Watts. A fabulous week for our girls.

In the modern day, with social media, it is very easy to criticise academy staff. Our staff freely give up their own time to run clubs, teams and performances, subsequently enriching academy life for all our children. I am ever so proud to work for staff who are dedicated to providing opportunities for all our children.
