
Croxby Primary School – School Uniform (Appendix 1)

Clox
YR - 5: Navy blue cardigan or sweatshirt (with or without logo).
YR - 5: White or school coloured polo shirt, shirt or blouse.
YR - 5: Grey trousers/skirt/shorts. A grey Pinafore may also be worn. In warmer weather, children can also wear: Navy blue gingham checked summer dress
YR - 6: Footwear: Black plain shoes, boots or trainers.



Prohibited Items

Extreme hairstyles: including unnatural colours like blue, green, pink, purple, bright red, and patterns such as tramlines cut into the hair.

Make-up: Not allowed.

Other Piercings: Not allowed. Skin coloured retainers are permitted.

Nail Polish: Not allowed

False or Acrylic Nails: Not allowed

False Eyelashes: Not allowed

Hoodies: Not allowed (Team members may buy hoodies and jumpers with the school logo, but they can't be worn as part of the school uniform, Leavers Hoodies are permitted at the discretion of the Headteacher).

Jewellery: No bracelets or necklaces should be worn. Children are advised not to bring any jewellery to school.

Smart Watches: Not allowed

Leggings: Not allowed

Personal Possessions

Mobile devices: Using mobile devices is prohibited on the school grounds (onsite out of sight). These devices must be switched off and handed into the class teacher at the start of the day. Audio equipment or speakers are also not allowed. If a child brings a mobile device or headphones or audio player to school, it is at their own risk. The school will not be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to these items. If the items are seen, they will be confiscated in line with the behaviour policy.

Money / Wristwatches / Jewellery Children are responsible for any small amounts of money or wristwatches or jewellery they bring to school.

Watches and jewellery

- A wristwatch with a plain strap
- One single pair of small stud earrings in the lobe of the ear

Additional safety requirement for Physical Education lessons:

- All jewellery must be removed for all physical activity
- It is a health and safety regulation that all learners must tie their hair back during any physical activity, where staff deem it necessary

Local Uniform Procedures

- 1.PE kits must be worn on PE days your child is allocated PE.
- 2. Hair accessories should be small and preferably school colours of grey, blue or red (no creative headbands large bows/accessories).
- 3. Wear wellies or waterproof shoes and a waterproof coat to access all areas of OPAL Play in any weather.
- 4. Mobile devices are only permitted for learners in **Year 6**. Devices must remain out of sight while on school grounds and must be handed in to the class teacher upon arrival.
