### **Foundation Stage**


Paint can be applied evenlyand with some accuracy to create a finished product representing something from the real world.



Children are beginning to mix the primary colours (red, yellow and blue) to create secondary colours (green, orange and purple).

Consistent and accurate painting coupled with a deeper understanding of depth and tone results in a sophisticated representation of the real world with increasing independence.




#### <u>Year 5</u>
