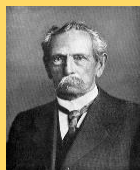




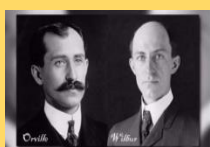
Key People

Cottingham in Hull, England a large village.



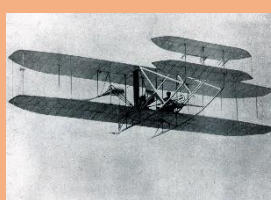
Kenya a country in the continent of Africa.

Now	Tilting trains

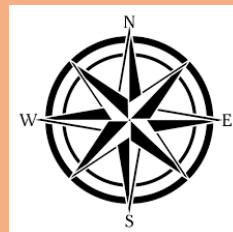
Key Concepts/Features

Travel has developed and changed over the years through inventors designing a product to fill a need. We can travel on land, water, air and space using different forms of transport.



Maps show that the world is split into seven continents and five oceans. Countries closer to the equator are hotter whereas countries closer to the polar regions are cooler. This affects the climate and weather patterns for all countries.

Compass directions (North, South, East and West) and directional language to describe the location features on a map. Basic symbols are used to construct a simple map to represent an area.



Key Vocabulary

Landmarks	An object or feature of a landscape or town that is easily seen and recognised from a distance
Human features	Natural objects such as rivers and rocks
Physical Features	Things that are built by humans such as bridges, houses
Equator	Imaginary line around the earth dividing it into northern and southern hemispheres
Aerial images	Photographs / images taken in the air to identify objects and landmarks
Continent	A very large area of land that consists of several countries
Country	The whole land or territory of a nation or state
Prototype	A first fully working model of a design
Aviator	A person who flies an aircraft
Pioneer	Someone who is the first to do something or go somewhere new
Inventor	Someone who creates or makes a new device
Invention	An object that has been created
