autumn	The season between summer and winter when the weather becomes cool and the leaves fall off
	the trees.
clouds	Clouds are usually white or grey in colour and float in the sky.
drought	A long period of time during which no rain falls.
flood	A large amount of water, which covers land.
hurricane	Extremely violent wind or storm.
lightening	A very bright flash of light in the sky that happens during thunderstorm.
seasons	There are four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter.
spring	Is the season between winter and summer when the weather becomes warmer and plants start to
	grow.
summer	Is the season between spring and autumn when the weather is usually warm or hot.
thunder	A loud rumble or crashing noise heard after a lightening flash.
tornado	A violent windstorm, which can cause a lot of damage.
winter	Is the season between autumn and spring when the weather is usually cold.
