#### **Curriculum Learners**

- As historians, we will study the legacy of Greek or Roman culture (art, architecture or literature) on later periods in British history, including the present day.
- As geographers, we will focus on Greece today, identifying its location within Europe using maps and describe the country's features. We will use a range of resources to investigate its main physical and human characteristics; in particular settlements and land use – linked to the tourism industry.
- As artists, we will use several different mediums to create artwork linked to Ancient Greece – including: mosaics, scratch pictures using pastels and acrylic paint, and continue to master skills using watercolours and charcoal and chalk sketches.
- In DT as designers, whilst learning about Ancient Greek architecture we will apply our understanding of how to strengthen, stiffen and, reinforce more complex structures – we will design a Greek structure with walls strong and stable enough to hold a solid roof.

## Additional Curriculum Learners

- As musicians, we will compose music that has a recognisable structure and play a piece with melody, chords, bass and rhythm parts.
- As explorers of faith, we will study unit 4.3: Our World.
- In computers, we will study Purple Mash unit 4.4 writing and 4.1 coding
- As linguists, we will read and write short phrases and pronounce words showing a knowledge of sound.
- As physically active pupils, we will develop skills in Multi Skills and Active Athletics.
