	<p>Queen Victoria (1819-1901) She ruled over Great Britain from 1837 to 1901. She ruled for 63 years and it was known as the Victorian era.</p>
	<p>Queen Elizabeth I (1533-1603) She was the first queen to rule over Great Britain. She reigned from 1558 to 1603 and it was known as the Golden Age.</p>
	<p>Tim Berners-Lee (1955 - present) He is an English computer scientist. He is credited with the invention of the World Wide Web.</p>

1829	Louis Braille invented the braille alphabet system, which allowed blind people to read.
1843	Ada Lovelace - first computer programmer.
1876	Alexander Graham Bell invented the telephone with the help of Thomas Watson.
1879	Thomas Edison invented the light bulb.
1983	Motorola invented the first mobile phone.
1989	Tim Berners Lee invented the World Wide Web with the first successful internet connection.
