

# **ANNE FRANK**

### 12TH JUNE 1929-FEB/MARCH 1945

## WHO WAS SHE?

Anne Marie Frank was a young, inspiring girl who was alive in World War 2. She was a Jewish girl which in those days was abominable, and the Nazis (the German government at the time) would send them to concentration camp, this was called The Holocaust. Anne decided to hide in a secret annex in her dad's office in Amsterdam to escape the Nazis and she wrote a diary- which lead her to fame.

#### WHO DID SHE HIDE WITH?

Anne Frank's annex was hidden behind a bookcase as you can see in the picture. She also had her Mum (Edith Frank), her older sister (Margot Frank), her dad (Otto Frank) and her the Van Pels family (Hermann, Peter and Auguste) who also hid with her.

#### OTTO FRANK

Anne wrote a diary, which she got from Otto Frank in June 1942. This was the year that the family begun hiding. Unfortunately in 1944 she got sent to a concentration camp where she later died the following year. All of the hiders died except Otto Frank who then died August 19<sup>th</sup> 1960 because of lung cancer.

Anne always started the entry to her diary with 'Dear Kitty'. Here are some quotes from her diary:

- "Think of all the beauty still left around you and be happy."
- "Whoever is happy will make others happy too."

  Her diary was how researchers found out all about this, they reckon she wrote in her diary a lot as she stored every memory in there. You can still visit her hiding place today in the country Amsterdam.
