School Context

Croxby Primary opened as part of The Consortium Academy Trust in October 2017. The school has a 52-place nursery, which enables 26 children to attend each session. In addition to this, there is also a local authority funded provision to support children with social, emotional, and mental health (SEMH) difficulties. The provision can only be accessed in agreement with the local authority for pupils with an EHCP plan, whose primary need is SEMH.

In 2022, Croxby Primary was inspected by Ofsted and judged to be 'Good' in all areas.

The school has approximately 362 pupils on roll from the Nursery class to Year 6. 22% of pupils are eligible for the pupil premium. Just under 3% of pupils have an EHCP plan, and 15% of children have additional needs. 11% of the children attending Croxby have English as an additional language. Attendance currently for this academic year is 96.2%, which is above the academic year 2023/2024, which was 96.1%.
