

# Curriculum Learners As geographers, understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of a region of the United Kingdom, a region in a European country, and a region within North or South America. We will study human geography, looking at the types of settlements and land use as well as economic activity including trade links. (Study the Rainforest, the tribes who live there, trade links, and locate major rivers in the world and compare to rivers in the UK) We will use maps, atlases, digital/computer mapping and globes to locate countries and describe their features. We will identify the position and significance of latitude, longitude, Equator, Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere and the Tropics.

- As artists, we will learn about great artists and improve our mastery of art and design technique (including drawing and painting) using different media
- In DT as chefs, we will understand and apply the principles of a healthy and varied diet We will prepare and cook a variety of predominantly savoury dishes using a range of cooking techniques (use a recipe to make chocolate bread/cake/biscuits and work out how much it will cost to make). We will understand seasonality and know where and how a variety of ingredients are grown, reared, caught and processed.
- In DT as mechanics, we will use appropriate mechanisms (such as levers, winding mechanisms, pulleys and gears) to make a packing machine for chocolates.
- As explorers of faith, we will study Unit 4.2 Saints and Heroes
- As mathematicians, we will investigate tessellation, learn about temperature around the world and understand working within a budget whilst problem solving.
- In computers, we will use Purple Mash to study 4.3 spreadsheets and 4.6 animation
- In Music, we will appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians –Whilst studying history of chocolate – match significant international composers and musicians.
