




ALBERT EINSTEIN



CHILDHOOD


Born: Friday 14th March 1879

Through his time at University he met a girl called Malaver which he took eyes to. After a long time, Albert said that he didn't enjoy teaching there so he moved to Berlin. After all of that moving he became a scientist - one of his equations was $E=mc^2$. He was a thinking scientist; the thing that he thought about the most was space and the travel of light.

After a long time being in Berlin, Albert Einstein thought some more when a solar eclipse would happen. Indeed it did, in 1919 when Albert was 40. His idea stretched and bended and to that day everyone knew it was his idea. Two years later he achieved an award for physics. After that he became worldwide famous, travelling the world telling everybody and everything explaining his own thoughts for years to come.



LIFE IN WORLD WAR TWO.

Life was hard for Albert in world war two because he was Jewish he didn't want to stay in Germany any longer so he moved to America. He went to University there which was full of knowledgeable people. That University was called Princeton. He was from Germany so he wrote a letter to the Prime Minister saying that he wanted to live in America for the rest of his life so he became a citizen.

Albert Einstein died on April 18, 1955, at age 76 at the University Medical Centre at Princeton.
