## CHRISTIANITY

Christianity is a religion followed by millions of people around the world. People who follow Christianity are called Christians. They believe in one God and follow the teachings of Jesus Christ.

## PLACE OF WORSHIP

Christians go to a church to pray, sing songs, and learn about God. Churches can be large or small, and many have tall towers or crosses on top. Inside, there are rows of seats, a special table called an altar, and sometimes beautiful stained-glass windows that show pictures from the Bible.

## HOLY BOOK

The Bible is the holy book of Christianity. It has two main parts: the Old Testament and the New Testament. The Bible is full of stories, teachings, and lessons about God, Jesus, and how people should live good and kind lives.

## RELIGIOUS SYMBOL

The main symbol of Christianity is the cross. It reminds Christians of Jesus and his love for the world. Many churches have a cross at the front, and some Christians wear a small cross as a necklace to show their faith.

## MAIN CELEBRATIONS

Christians celebrate special days throughout the year.

- Christmas is when they remember the birth of Jesus. Many people give gifts, sing carols, and spend time with their families.
- Easter is when Christians celebrate that Jesus rose from the dead after being crucified. People often go to church, and some children take part in Easter egg hunts.

## VALUES

Christianity teaches people to be loving, kind, and honest. Christians try to forgive others, help those in need, and treat everyone with respect. They believe in sharing, caring, and always trying to do what is right.



## KEY STORIES

The Bible has many stories that teach important lessons.

- The Good Samaritan is about a man who helps a stranger in need, showing kindness and love to everyone.
- Noah's Ark tells of a man named Noah who built a huge boat to save his family and many animals from a great flood.
- Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand is a story where Jesus shares a small amount of food and makes it enough to feed a huge crowd.
- Christianity teaches people to believe in God, be kind, and help others whenever they can.
