


DINOSAURS

FACTS


- It is believed that dinosaurs lived on Earth until around 65 million years ago when a mass extinction occurred.
- Remains of dinosaurs, called fossils, are found all over the world.
- Dinosaurs hatched from eggs.
- Scientists are unsure of the colour of dinosaurs. They probably think they had green or brown skin to help the camouflage (blend in).
- Some dinosaurs were carnivores (meat eaters) like the Tyrannosaurus rex
- Some dinosaurs were omnivores (eat meat and plants) like the Oviraptor.
- Some dinosaurs were herbivores (plants eaters) like the Diplodocus.




A T-Rex can grow up to 6 metres tall. The T-Rex had a large brain which helped it to hunt better.



The Stegosaurus was a herbivore (plant eater). On average, a stegosaurus was around 9 metres long



The Triceratops was a herbivore (plant eater). The Triceratops can have up to 800 teeth.



A Diplodocus was a herbivore (plant eater). A Diplodocus is thought to be the longest dinosaur.
