

## ARTISTS


### Wassily Kandinsky



Kandinsky was born in Russia in 1866. He died aged 78 in 1944.

Kandinsky began to study art when he was 30.

Kandinsky thought a lot about what colours mean and how they make people feel.



### Alma Thomas




Thomas was born in Georgia USA in 1891. She died aged 86 in 1978.

Thomas enrolled at University at 30. She was the first person to graduate studying fine arts.

Thomas began creating colour field paintings.



### Piet Mondrian




Mondrian was born in the Netherlands in 1872. He died aged 71 in 1944 in New York.

Mondrian became a primary school teacher and painted in his spare time.


He first painted landscapes which was very popular in the Netherlands at the time.

He developed a style which used lines, black, white, grey and primary colours.





## COLOURS



There are three primary colours. These are red, yellow and blue. These are considered the root of every other colour. They cannot be created by a mixture.

There are three secondary colours. These are orange, purple and green. These colours are created by mixing two primary colours together.
