Dear Parents/Carers,

As I am sure you are aware, your child will be sitting their KS2 SATs tests week commencing 13th May 2024. It is important that they are in school every day and on time to complete these statutory tests. If your child is unwell any day, please notify the office at **8.00am** and someone from our senior leadership team will contact you to see how we can support you.

The timetable will be as follows:

Monday: English grammar, punctuation and spelling papers 1 and 2 Tuesday: English reading Wednesday: Maths papers 1 and 2 Thursday: Maths paper 3

There are some things you can do to support your child through this week.

- Make sure they get a good night's sleep before each test.
- Ensure they have a good breakfast and send them in a healthy snack to eat at break time.
- Ensure your child has an opportunity to go outside and get some fresh air after finishing school and has reduced screen time to enable them to sleep well.
- If they are feeling anxious, encourage them to talk to you and us. We can help you and them through this.
- Plan something fun and exciting the weekend before and after SATs. A trip to a park or see a relative or friend or perhaps a special tea. This will help them start the week well and give them something to look forward to at the end!

Remember, SATs breakfast will be available every morning during the SATs from 8.15am in their classroom and staff will be at these breakfasts to support and chat to the children. Entry via the classroom door as normal.

Your children have been working so hard for this and are prepared for the routines and style of questions in these papers. They are more than ready. It is their time to shine and show off all of the learning which has taken place during their time at Croxby.
