FAQs

PGL staff: A senior member of staff takes the role of 'course leader' supervising and overseeing our school throughout the stay. An instructor takes the role of 'group leader' for each of the groups. Children are always supervised. Overnight there are specialist night duty staff.

What should my child pack?

- Please find attached a suggested list from PGL
- PGL will provide equipment necessary for specific adventure activities.
- **Sleeping bag/duvet/pillow are required and should be in a bag (bin bag is fine!)**

What should be left at home?

- Mobile phones
- Any food
- Anything electrical/valuable e.g. iPads, handheld computer games etc.
- Cameras
- Aerosol sprays
- Both PGL and Croxby cannot accept liability for the loss or damage of any such items.

Wednesday 22nd May

- Children are to arrive at the normal time via their classroom door, wearing clothes suitable for outside activities (refer to list).
- Your child will need to bring a packed lunch in a disposable bag
- Ensure all luggage is labelled with their name and school
- The coach will leave school around 10.00am
- A text will be sent to let you know we have safely arrived at Newby Wiske

Friday 24th May

- We will leave at approximately 2.00pm.
- The children will return around 4.15pm. **All children will need collecting from the classroom door by an adult.** If the coach is later than expected, we will dismiss the children from the top of the drive.
- It is important we have the correct mobile telephone number on which to contact you on. Please check these via your Arbor account.

Medical/Dietary Needs

- PGL have already been informed of medical/dietary needs for the children as per the information on our system provided by parents/carers.
- **Medical Plan and Inhalers** – if your child has a medical plan which requires medication during the school day or an inhaler in school, please ensure we have everything we need to support your child.
- If your child requires travel sickness medication for the coach journey, you will be required to complete the necessary form in advance of the trip. The medication form can be downloaded from our website or collected from the office and must be completed and returned by **Monday 20th May** with the travel sickness medication to the office.
- **Please ensure the times for administering the medication is clearly marked on the form.**

Things to consider:

- Please do not send any new or expensive items/non-dry items. Make sure clothes are labelled and marked with names.
- Dietary concerns are catered for, and the centre are aware of any dietary requirements we hold about your child in school.
- Suntan lotion: May be necessary at this time of year so please send some as a lot of the activities, although shaded as much as possible, are located outside. Pupils will need to be responsible for their own protection. This needs to be clearly labelled with your child's name.
- Money: There is a souvenir/tuck shop on site that the children will be allowed to visit. Money is brought at your child's own risk, and they should bring no more than £10.
- **Children will not be allowed to contact home during the visit.**
- **Emergency contacts need to be up to date.**
