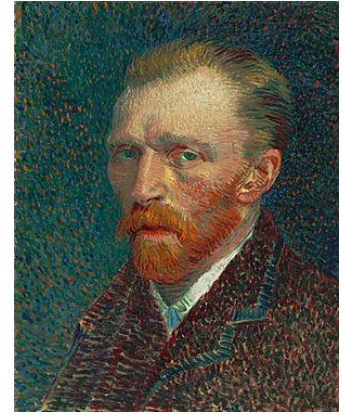




# VINCENT VAN GOGH



## WHERE AND WHEN HE WAS BORN
