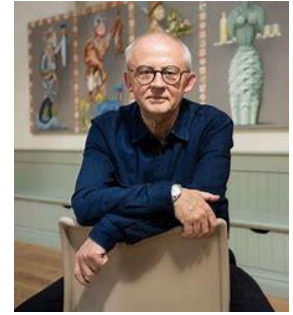




JOHN KINDNESS
