## EARLY LIFE

Georgia O'Keeffe was born on 15 November 1887 in Sun Prairie, Wisconsin, USA. She grew up on a farm with her six siblings. From a young age, she enjoyed drawing and painting, often inspired by the nature around her.

## STUDYING ART

As a young woman, she decided to study art to improve her skills. She attended several schools, including the Art Institute of Chicago and the Art Students League in New York City. She worked hard and became very skilled at drawing and painting.
