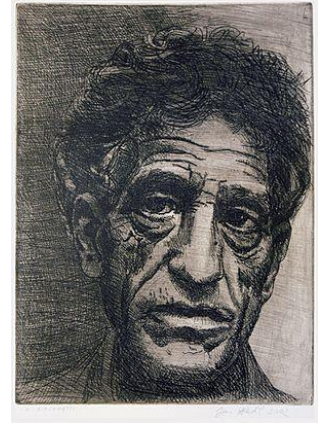


ALBERTO GIACOMETTI



WHO WAS ALBERTO GIACOMETTI?

Alberto Giacometti was a famous artist and sculptor. He was born on 10 October 1901 in a small village called Borgonovo in Switzerland. His family was artistic, and his father, Giovanni, was a painter. This helped Alberto grow up with a love for art.
