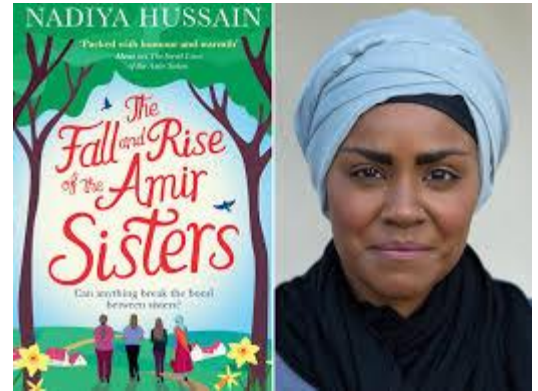




NADIYA HUSSAIN
