HUMANISM: A WAY TO BE KIND AND HELPFUL

Humanists do not have big religious festivals. However, they celebrate special events like birthdays, weddings, or important family moments. They enjoy spending time with family and friends, having fun, and sharing happiness with others.

VALUES

Humanists believe in being kind, honest, and fair. They think that it is important to help other people, no matter where they live, and to care for the planet. They also believe that every person should be treated with respect, and that we all have a part to play in making the world a better place.



KEY STORIES
